

We are excited to see you grow as an FEC leader and as a leader in your community. We are here to help you build your community by providing resources and ideas. Here are a few tips to help you organize your gatherings.

- 1. Plan out your space
 - a. Be sure your space has adequate room for the entire group
 - b. Make plans for dividing into different age groups (if applicable)
 - c. Plan a space for the food/snacks
- 2. Delegate Responsibilities
 - d. You may want to divide up the teaching/activities according to the ages of children in the participating families. That way, everyone has a role to play and is needed in the group, and the preparation is manageable for everyone. These responsibilities can rotate each gathering, or they can be assigned for the month.
- 3. Sample Agenda:
 - e. **Welcome**: Warmly welcome families
 - f. Pledge of Allegiance: Rise together and honor the flag by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance
 - g. **Song**: A song can be unifying and lets the students learn true principles through music. You may have a student lead the music.
 - h. **Prayer:** A parent or child may give the opening prayer. Often it is kind to ask the group what they would like to pray for.
 - i. **Announcements**: Use this time to remind families of the plan for the celebration and what is expected.
 - j. Break into groups to begin learning activities!

Optional ideas to incorporate into your gathering agenda:

- Memorize a scripture or poem together and practice it each time you gather
- Student spotlight
- Student share: Give students a few minutes to share something they learned or projects they have completed
